

Logger Pro Basics Video Analysis Window



Select Point: Allows you to select a single point you've placed in the video analysis window. I haven't found a good use for this button.

Add Point: This is how you add a new point. Each time you click this a data point will be added and the video will advance one frame. You can skip ahead by pressing the next frame button as well (in case you don't want a data point on every frame).

Set Origin: This sets the zero point for X and Y position.

Set Scale: Defines the scale. In all the motion videos that come with Logger Pro you will find a meter stick somewhere. We've found it useful to make a longer meter stick in our own videos to improve accuracy. (In the video above the meter stick is laying on the desk)

Set Active Point: You can actually break up your data into separate sets as you add points. In case you want points up and down to be in different data sets.

Toggle Trails: Show or hide your points on the video. Can be handy if your previous points obscure the motion.

Show Origin: Show or hide your origin on the video.
